



# Liturgy of the Hours: Week III of the Psalter Reflection on the Gospel

The Invitation to change our ways is rarely appealing. Yet in today's readings, the Ninevites instantly repent at Jonah's preaching and the fishermen immediately leave their nets to follow Jesus. There is an urgency, and a totality of response is needed. In Ordinary Time, it may seem natural to settle into the ordinary ways we've been living our discipleship. Instead, these Scriptures tell us that a new time presses upon us, requiring different responses than before. There is nothing ordinary about the invitation to follow Jesus more radically.


