ROSARY: Daily, following the 9:00 am Mass.


PRAYER GROUP: Wednesdays, following the 9:00 am Mass.

## Liturgy of the Hours: Of the Solemnity Reflection on the Gospel

What Jesus says and does at the Last Supper is the culmination of an entire lifelong pouring out of himself in love. The words and gestures echo God's life-sustaining self-gift to Israel in the wilderness, symbolized in manna (Exod 16:12-35), and Jesus's feeding of the hungry multitudes during his Galilean ministry (Mark 6:30-44; 8:1-9). In Mark's Gospel, the Last Supper is a Passover meal, recalling how the blood of lambs smeared on the doorposts kept the fleeing Israelites safe from the destroyer and opened the way to their liberation.
