**PRAYER GROUP:** Wednesdays, following the 9:00 am Mass.

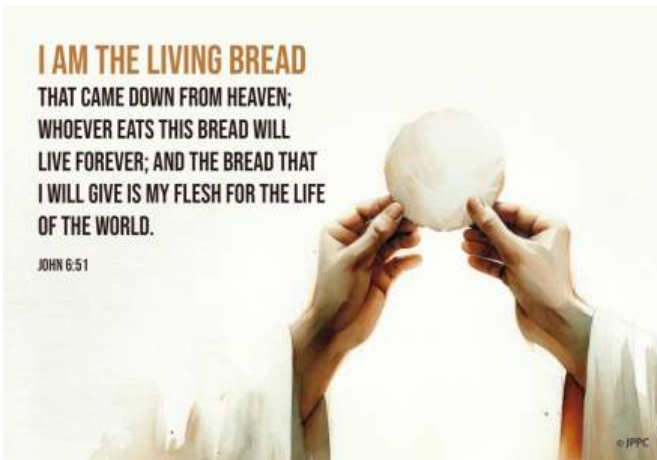

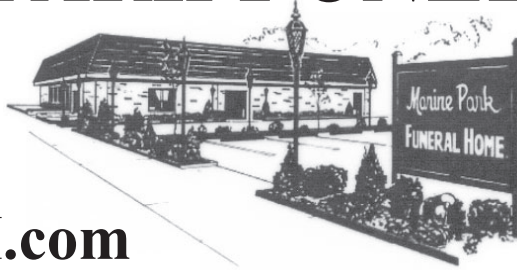
