In today's gospel, people bring to Jesus a man with a hearing and speech impediment. When the man's hearing is restored, the first voice he will hear is that of Jesus, inviting him to greater openness. Jesus draws close to the man, touches his ears and tongue, and pronounces a word that Mark preserves in Aramaic: "Ephphatha!' —that is, "Be opened!" We follow the pattern today with our sacraments, using words, physical touch, and the tangible signs of oil, water, bread, and wine, which have power to transform.
