SACRAMENT OF THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK: Sick calls any day or night by calling the Rectory.

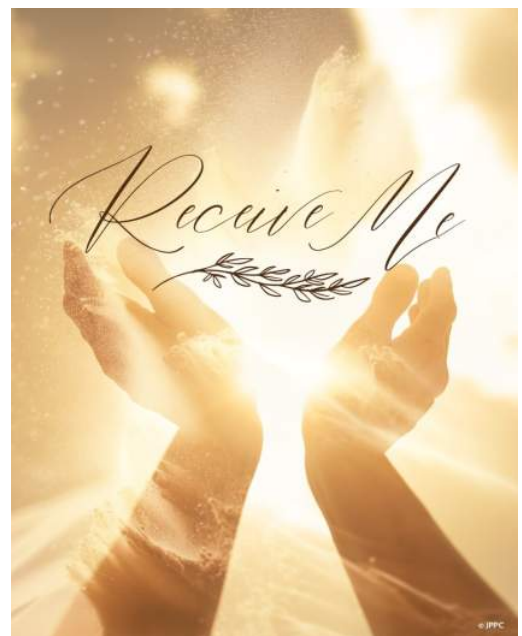
EXPOSITION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT: First Fridays, following the 9:00 am Mass. Angelus and Benediction at 11:00am.

ROSARY: Daily, following the 9:00 am Mass.

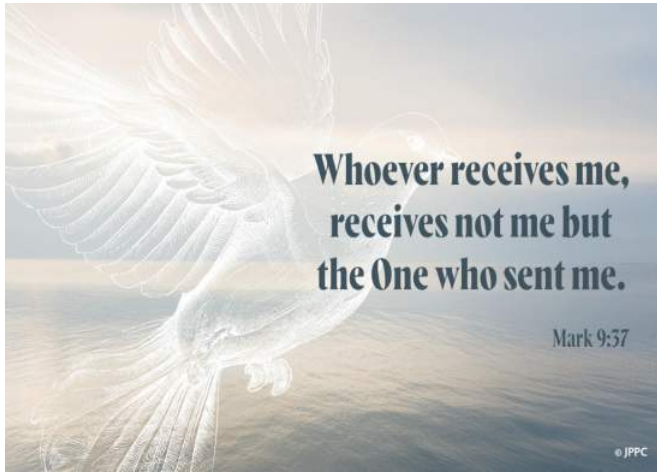
PRAYER GROUP: Wednesdays, following the 9:00 am Mass.

Once we exceed our goal we will then receive 100% of all funds raised above this figure directly back to our parish.

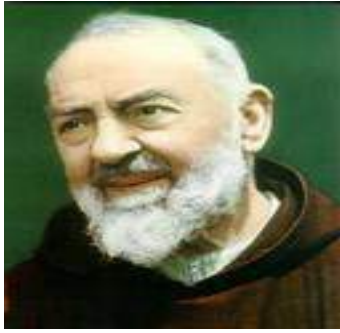

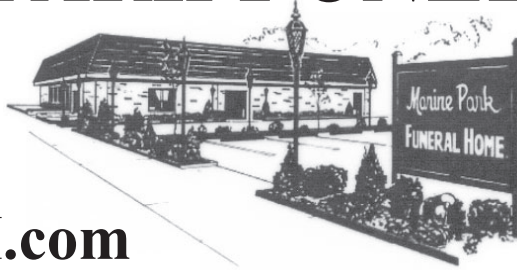
